The purpose of this amendment is to update the section of the Capital Regional District (CRD) Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) which pertains to funding of capital works projects at Hartland.

AMENDMENT

- 1.0 Delete Section 15.1, Capital Works Projects, in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - 15.1 Capital Works Projects

Funding for all Hartland capital works will be borrowed through loan authorization bylaws or cash flow generated from solid waste operations in accordance with the CRD *Solid Waste Disposal Local Services Establishment Bylaws*.

2.0 Delete from Appendix H – Hartland Capital Development Plan, page iv, the section, <u>Capital</u> <u>Works Cost Estimates</u>, and replace with the following:

<u>Capital Works Cost Estimates:</u> The planned capital works for Hartland from 2008 to 2012, together with the estimated costs, are listed on the attached Table 1. Engineering, taxes and CRD bylaw costs are not included.

This amendment supersedes any other part of the CRD Solid Waste Management Plan Revision 2 which it is in conflict with or in disagreement with this amendment.
