- Fawn Lily (*Erythronium oregonum*, *E. revolutum*)
- Shooting star (*Dodecatheon hendersonii*)
- Western buttercup (*Ranunculus occidentalis*)
- Field chickweed (*Cerastium arvense*)
- Sea blush (*Plectritis congesta*)

Mid-Spring Bloomers

- Nodding onion (*Allium cernuum*)
- Fool's onion (*Triteleia hyacinthina*)
- Hooker's onion (*Allium acuminatum*)
- Tiger lily (*Lilium canadensis*)
- Yarrow (*Achilla millefolium*)
- Death camas (*Zygadenus venenosus*)
- Menzie's larkspur (*Delphinium menzeisii*)
- Goldenrod (*Solidago canadensis*)
- Woolly sunflower (*Eriophyllum lanatum*)
- Lupine (*Lupinus arcticus*, *L. polyphyllus*)
