

Overnight Parking for Permit Holders

A pilot project of the Capital Regional District and District of Central Saanich is providing ten overnight parking spaces as an amenity for kayakers and canoeists launching from Island View Beach Regional Park.

Parking Rules

- Parking permits can be obtained in-person from the District of Central Saanich Community Services Department during regular office hours at a fee of \$10/day on a first-come, first-served basis. 1903 Mount Newton Cross Road, Saanichton, BC | 250-652-4444 www.centrialsaanich.ca
- Length of stay is limited to those dates shown on the permit, up to 10 days maximum.
- Permits cannot be renewed or extended, and are not transferable.
- Passenger-size vehicles up to 20' in length only are allowed. Boat trailers are not allowed.
- Vehicles not displaying permits and vehicles left longer than the end date displayed on the permit are subject to towing at the owner's expense. Peninsula Towing 250-656-6911.
- Parking spaces are not to be used for camping.
- Neither the District of Central Saanich nor the CRD are responsible for the safety or security of parked vehicles. Visitors are reminded that they are required by the Motor Vehicle Act to lock their vehicle.
