
Strathcona Hotel saves dollars, gas & water

Strathcona Hotel has continually invested in water efficient technology and have realized dramatic savings on their water and energy bills. In 2014, they replaced their Once-Through Cooling (OTC) with a closed-loop system connected to a heat exchanger. Although the entire project cost approximately \$150,000, the combined annual savings in water and gas consumption payed back their investment in less than two years. Since then, they have changed out all of the toilets and urinals, and most recently, in partnership with the Capital Regional District (CRD), have installed low flow aerators on sink faucets throughout the facility.

"We changed out all the hotel room toilets [and] we have renovated all the public washrooms and installed touch-free low-flow fixtures. The urinals are 0.5 lpf and the toilets 4.8 lpf. That would be approximately 150 fixtures we have changed in the last 8–10 years!" - *Curt Gale, Maintenence Manager at the Strathcona Hotel, and CRD Water Conservation Partner*
