Pay-by-weight Materials	Rate/tonne (1,000 kgs)	Extra fees
General refuse	\$155	\$10 bin fee charged once per visit
Mattresses + box springs		
Clean wood (pallets, crating, lumber)	\$80	
Treated wood (painted, stained or pressure treated)	\$110	
Asphalt shingles		
Branches + stumps (greater than 75 mm/3" in diameter)	\$110	\$10 minimum charge
Yard + garden material (branches less than 75 mm/3" in diameter)	\$59	
Kitchen scraps	\$140	N/A
Your vehicle is weighed before and after dropping off materials, payment is calculated on the weight difference.		
Example: 250 kgs (550 lbs) of general refuse = \$48.75 (\$38.75 + \$10 bin fee)
