| General refuse  | \$150                     | \$10 bin fee charged once per visit |

| Clean wood (pallets, crating, lumber)   | \$80                      |                                     |
| Treated wood (painted, stained or pressure treated)   | \$110                     |                                     |

| Branches + stumps<br>(greater than 75 mm/3" in diameter)  | \$110                     | \$10 minimum charge                 |
