School names of Walk and Wheel to School participants will be posted on our website no later than October 2, 2017. Participating schools registered by September 15 will receive a school package to promote, encourage and track student participation. Students will participate in the Walk and Wheel to School challenge from October 2, 2017 to October 7, 2017. Schools that participate in the Walk and Wheel to School Week program will complete the final survey and provide a picture of their Walk and Wheel to School tracking poster and stickers to the Walk and Wheel to School Program Coordinator by [email](#), fax (250.360.3047), mail or in person at 625 Fisgard St., PO Box 1000, Victoria, BC, V8W 2S6 by October 20, 2017. Winning participants will be notified by October 31, 2017. Prizes and awards for the winning Walk and Wheel to School participants will be awarded directly to participants in a timely manner.
