- Goldenrod (*Solidago canadensis*) P - flower

- Aster (*Aster chilensis*, *A. modestus*, *A. subspicatus*) P - flower
- Pearly everlasting (*Anaphalis margaritacea*) P - flower

Winter (October - January)

- Silk tassel plant (*Garrya elliptica*) S - evergreen
- Common snowberry (*Symphoricarpos albus*) S - berries
- Nootka rose (*Rosa nutkana*) S - rosehips
- Kinnickinick (*Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*) S - evergreen
- Hairy manzanita (*Arctostaphylos columbianum*) S - evergreen
- Snowbrush (*Ceanothus velutinus*) S - evergreen
- Salal (*Gaultheria shallon*) S - evergreen
- Tall/short Oregon grape (*Mahonia aquifolium*, *M. nervosa*) S - evergreen
- Red osier dogwood (*Cornus stolonifera*) S - red stems
