BYLAW NO. 3348

**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 2721, BEING
CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT PARKS REGULATION BYLAW NO. 1, 1999**

WHEREAS the Capital Regional District wishes to amend Capital Regional District Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 1, 1999 to allow for the use of certain types of motor assisted cycles within regional parks and trails;

NOW THEREFORE, Capital Regional District Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 1, 1999 is amended as follows:

1. Section 1 is amended by adding the following definition between the definitions of "model" and "motor vehicle":

“ ‘motor assisted cycle’ means a motor assisted cycle that meets the requirements of the Motor Assisted Cycle Regulation, B.C. Reg. 151/2002 made pursuant to the *Motor Vehicle Act*.”.

2. By deleting the definition of "motor vehicle" and replacing it with the following:

“ ‘motor vehicle’ means a vehicle, not run on rails, that is designed to be self propelled, other than a motor assisted cycle;”.

3. Section 23 "Cycles" is deleted and replaced with the following:

"Cycles and Motor Assisted Cycles

23. (1) No person shall bring or ride any cycle in a park or on a trail except on public roads and trails designated for such use by a sign.

(2) No person shall bring or ride any motor assisted cycle in a park or on a trail except on public roads and trails designated for cycling.

- (3) Subsections (1) and (2) do not apply to authorized personnel patrolling on a cycle in a park or on a trail.
- (4) No person shall ride in a park or on a trail a motor assisted cycle which has a motor rated in excess of five hundred (500) watts and is capable of propelling the cycle at a speed greater than thirty-two (32) kilometres per hour on level ground, without pedalling."

4. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Capital Regional District Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 1, 1999, Amendment Bylaw No. 1, 2006."
