

Elk/Beaver Lake Boating Regulations

(Transport Canada – Canada Shipping Act)

- Maximum 10 horsepower vessels are permitted on Beaver Lake and the east half of Elk Lake.
- Over 10 horsepower vessels are permitted on the west half of Elk Lake except within 10 metres of the north shore.
(White buoys with orange decals mark the boundary between the maximum 10 horsepower and over 10 horsepower zones.)
- Power-driven vessels towing people on water-skis or other equipment are prohibited between sunrise and 11 am.
- Over 10 horsepower vessels are prohibited during rowing events.
- A permit from Transport Canada is required for lake events (i.e., regatta, swimming event). Submit event applications to CRD Parks by July 31 each year for events to be held the following year. Applications are reviewed by the Elk/Beaver Lake Recreational Use Advisory Group and Transport Canada.
