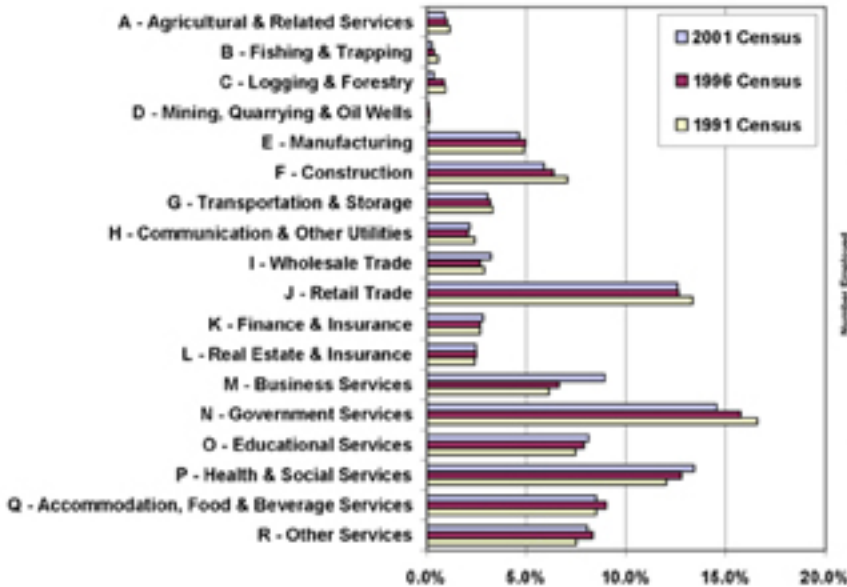


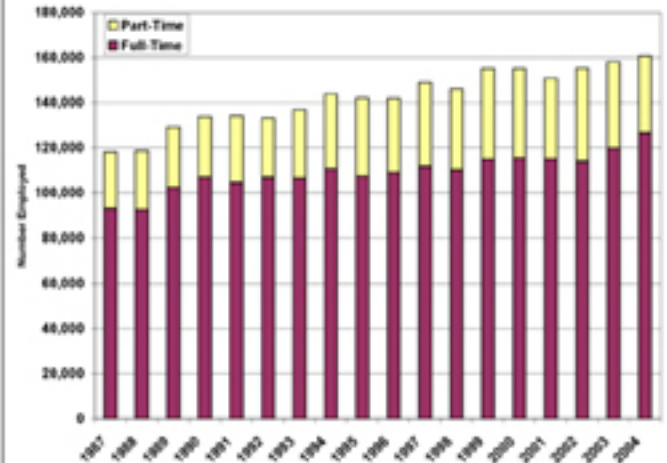

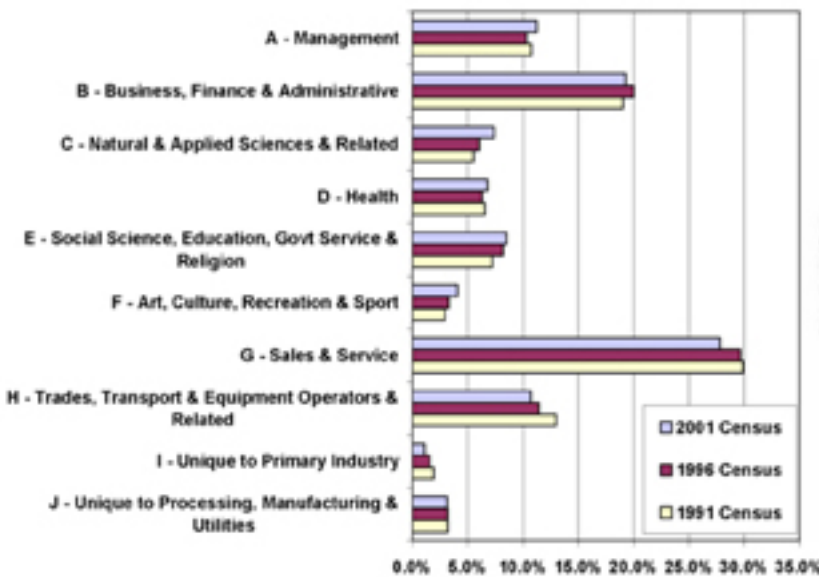
Labour Force by Industry
Victoria CMA, 2001, 1996, 1991



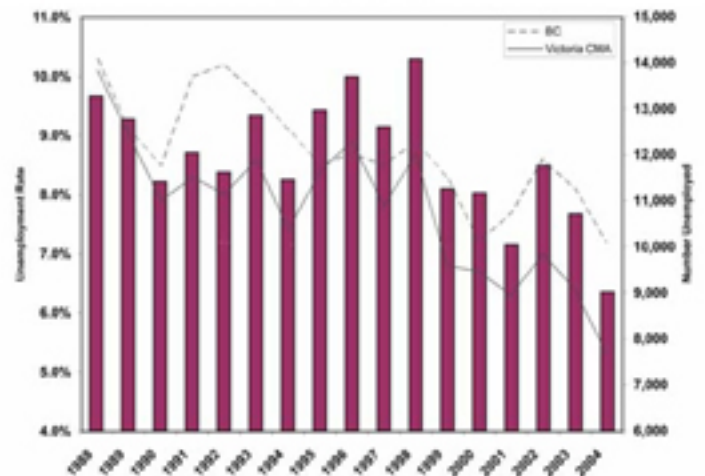
Full-Time and Part-Time Employment
