Learn, play and grow at SEAPARC

Our philosophy at Doodle Bugs Preschool is to allow the children to learn and discover the world around them through play while exploring their own unique interests. Through outdoor play, activity centres and circle time children are learning to socialize with their peers, take turns with toys, gain independence and deal with conflict in appropriate ways which helps to build the foundation for the routines of kindergarten and beyond. We provide a variety of options each day at the activity centres and in our fenced outdoor play area which relate to the beginning of academic learning (ex. recognizing their own name) as well as our monthly theme (ex. community heroes, oceans). We leave it up to the children to decide how much or how little they would like to engage in each of the activities. This is followed by a structured circle time full of stories, puppet shows and fun. Parents are asked to send a healthy snack and water each day for their child.

Each month you will receive a calendar that tells you what we will be focusing on and list any out trips that we have planned. Some of our out trips require registration for those who choose to participate. Last season, we enjoyed such trips as Butterfly World, Aylard Farms, Galey Farms (pumpkin patch and hay ride), Empress Hotel (Festival of Trees), a local hobby farm and an apiary to see how bees make honey!

Frequently Asked Questions:

How old does my child need to be to register?

Children must be of the appropriate age before December 31, 2011 in order to register for our pre-school programs.

Does my child need to be toilet trained before they can take this program?

Yes, children must be toilet trained prior to enrollment.

Are parents expected to participate?

Parent involvement is not expected on a daily basis but we do encourage parents to participate in field trips and skate or swim days.

What happens if I am going to be late for pick-up?

Should I send my child with a drink or snack?

Yes, please send a healthy snack and a drink each day.
