



## Evergreen Native Plants

### Shrubs

- Evergreen huckleberry (*Vaccinium ovatum*)
- Salal (*Gaultheria shallon*)
- Western tea berry (*Gaultheria ovatifolia*)
- Pacific rhododendron (*Rhododendron macrophyllum*)
- Manzanita (*Arctostaphylos colombiana* and *A. x media*)
- Kinnickinick (*Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*)
- Snowbrush (*Ceanothus velutinus*)
- Common juniper (*Juniperus communis*)
- Falsebox (*Pachistima myrsinites*)
- Oregon-grape (*Mahonia aquifolium*-tall, *M. nervosa*-short, *M. repens*-creeping)
- Crowberry (*Empetrum nigrum*)

### Perennials

- Nodding onion (*Allium cernuum*)
- Penstemon (*Penstemon serrulatus*) \* There are many non-native varieties
- Stonecrop (*Sedum lanceolatum*, *S. oregonum*, *S. spathulifolium*) \* *S. acre* is invasive
- Rattlesnake plantain (*Goodyera oblongifolia*)
- Twinflower (*Linnaea borealis*)
- Pink mountain heather (*Phyllodoce empetrifolmi*)
- Strawberry (*Fragaria chiloensis*, *F. vesca*, *F. virginiana*)\*\*
- Alumroot (*Heuchera glabra* & *H. micrantha*)\*\*
- Fringecup (*Tellima grandiflora*, *Lithophragma glabrum*)\*\*

\*\* Plants may not stay green during very cold winters

### Ferns

- Sword fern (*Polystichum munitum*)
- Licorice fern (*Polystichum glycyrrhiza*)- green all winter, dies back in summer
