



Native Meadow Flowers and Grasses

Early Spring Bloomers

- Camas (*Camassia quamash* & *C. leichtlinii*)
- Chocolate lily (*Fritellaria lanceolata*)
- Shooting star (*Dodecatheon hendersonii*, *D. pulchellum*, *D. jeffreyi*)
- Fawn Lily (*Erythronium oregonum*, *E. revolutum*)
- Menzie's larkspur (*Delphinium menzeisii*)
- Western buttercup (*Ranunculus occidentalis*) * *R. repens* is an invasive variation of the Western buttercup
- Field chickweed (*Cerastium arvense*)
- Satin flower (*Sisyrinchium douglasii*) – mostly on rocky outcrops
- Sea blush (*Plectritis congesta*) – mostly on rocky outcrops
- Blue-eyed mary (*Collinsia grandiflora*) – mostly on rocky outcrops

Mid-Spring Bloomers

- Nodding onion (*Allium cernuum*)
- Fool's onion (*Triteleia hyacinthina*)
- Hooker's onion (*Allium acuminatum*)
- Tiger lily (*Lilium canadensis*)
- Canada goldenrod (*Solidago canadensis*) * Invasive varieties exist. (*S. rugosa* is introduced)
- Northern goldenrod (*Solidago multiradiata*) * Invasive varieties exist. (*S. rugosa* is introduced)
- Yarrow (*Achilla millefolium*) * This species can be aggressive and may be considered invasive at times
- Woolly sunflower (*Eriophyllum lanatum*)
- Lupine (*Lupinus micranthus*, *L. bicolor*, *L. vallicola*)
- Sitka columbine (*Aquilegia formosa*)
- Alumroot (*Heuchera glabra*, *H. micrantha*)

Late Bloomers

- Pearly everlasting (*Anaphalis margaritacea*)
- Canada goldenrod (*Solidago canadensis*)* Invasive variations exist. (*S. rugosa* is introduced)
- Northern goldenrod (*Solidago multiradiata*)* Invasive variations exist. (*S. rugosa* is introduced)
- Yarrow (*Achilla millefolium*)* This species can be aggressive and may be considered invasive at times

Grasses

- Alaska onion grass (*Melica subulata*)
- Roemer's fescue (*Festuca idahoensis*)
- California oatgrass (*Danthonia californica*)
