Flower/Berry – Colour

Reds/Pinks

- Nootka & Baldhip rose (*Rosa nutkana*, *R. gymnocarpa*) S
- Red elderberry (*Sambucus racemosa*) S
- Salmonberry (*Rubus spectabilis*) S
- Red flowering currant (*Ribes sanguineum*) S
- Nodding onion (*Allium cernuum*) B
- Pacific bleeding heart (*Dicentra formosa*) P
- Sitka columbine (*Aquilegia formosa*) P
- Shooting star (*Dodecatheon hendersonii*, *D. pulchellum*, *D. jeffreyi*) P
- Sea blush (*Plectritis congesta*) Annual

Yellows/Oranges

- Tall and short, oregon grape (*Mahonia aquifolium*, *M. nervosa*) (flower) S
- Orange honeysuckle (*Lonicera ciliosa*) S
- Tiger lily (*Lilium columbianum*) B
- Spring gold (*Lomatium utriculatum*) P
- Western buttercup (*Ranunculus occidentalis*) * *R. repens* is an invasive variation of the Western buttercup P
- Woolly sunflower (*Eriophyllum lanatum*) P
- Canadian goldenrod (*Solidago canadensis*) P * Invasive varieties exist (*S. Rugosa* is introduced)
- Stonecrop (*Sedum spathifolium*, *S. lanceolatum*, *S. oregonum*) * The variation (*S. acre* is invasive) P
- Monkey flower (*Mimulus guttatus*) P

Blues/Purples

- Blue elderberry (*Sambucus caerulea*) S
- Tall and short, oregon-grape (*Mahonia aquifolium* *M. nervosa*) (berry) S
- Satin flower (*Olsynium douglasii*) P

- Camas (*Camassia quamash* & *C. leichtlinii*) B
- Hooker's onion (*Allium acuminatum*) B
- Harvest brodiaea (*Brodiaea coronaria*) B
- Blue-eyed mary (*Collinsia grandiflora*) P
- Menzie's larkspur (*Delphinium menziesii*) P
- Penstemon (*Penstemon serrulatus*) P * There are many varieties that are non-native/invasive

Whites

- Oceanspray (*Holodiscus discolor*) S
- Saskatoon (*Amelanchier alnifolia*) S
- Mock-orange (*Philadelphus lewisii*) S
- Fawn lily (*Erythronium oregonum*, *E. revolutum*) B
- Yarrow (*Erythronium oregonum*) P * This species can be aggressive and may be considered invasive
- Western trillium (*Trillium ovatum*) P
- Woodland strawberry (*Fragaria vesca*) P
- Coastal strawberry (*Fragaria chiloensis*) P
- Fool's onion (*Brodiaea hyacinthina*) B
- Alumroot (*Heuchera micrantha* & *H. glabra*) P

Seasonal Interest

Early Spring (Feb/Mar)

- Indian plum (*Oemleria cerasiformis*) S
- Satin flower (*Olsynium douglasii*) P
- Shooting star (*Dodecatheon hendersonii*, *D. pulchellum*, *D. jeffreyi*) P
- Tall and short, Oregon grape (*Mahonia aquifolium*, *M. nervosa*) (flower) S
- Red flowering currant (*Ribes sanguineum*) S
- Western buttercup (*Ranunculus occidentalis*) * *R. repens* is an invasive variation of the Western buttercup P

Early Summer (May/June)

- Saskatoon (*Amelanchier alnifolia*) S
- Oceanspray (*Holodiscus discolor*) S
- Mock-orange (*Philadelphus lewisii*) S
- Nodding onion (*Allium cernuum*) B
- Fool's onion (*Brodiaea hyacinthina*) B
- Orange honeysuckle (*Lonicera ciliosa*) S
- Hooker's onion (*Allium acuminatum*) B
- Tiger lily (*Lilium columbianum*) B
- Woolly sunflower (*Eriophyllum lanatum*) P

- Alumroot (*Heuchera micrantha*) P
- Penstemon (*Penstemon serrulatus*) P * There are many varieties that are non-native/invasive

Fall (Aug/Sept/Oct)

- Evergreen huckleberry (*Vaccinium ovatum*) S
- Tall and short, oregon grape (*Mahonia aquifolium*, *M. nervosa*) (flower) S
- Sword fern (*Polystichum munitum*) F
- Licorice fern (*Polypodium glycyrrhia*) F
- Yarrow (*Erythronium oregonum*) P * This species can be aggressive and may be considered invasive
- Canadian goldenrod (*Solidago canadensis*) * Invasive varieties exist (*S. rugosa* is introduced) P

Spring (Mar/Apr/May)

- Camas (*Camassia quamash* C. *leichtlinii*) B
- Chocolate lily (*Fritellaria lanceolatum*) B
- Fawn lily (*Erythroniu oregonum*, *E. revolutum*) B
- Western buttercup (*Ranunculus occidentalis*) P * *R. repens* is an invasive variation of the Western buttercup
- Sea blush (*Plectritis congesta*) (annual)
- Saxifrage (*Saxifraga ferruginea*, *S. integrifolia*, *S. mertensiana*, *S. occifentelis*) P

Summer (Jun/Jul/Aug)

- Blue elderberry (*Sambucus caerulea*) S
- Goat's beard (*Aruncus dioicus*) P * there is an invasive species (*Tragopogon dubius*) that shares the common name 'Goats Beard'.
- Canada goldenrod (*Solidago canadensis*) * Invasive varieties exist (*S. rugosa* is introduced) P
- Yarrow (*Erythronium oregonum*) P * This species can be aggressive and may be considered invasive
- Pearly everlasting (*Anaphalis margaritacea*) P
- Penstemon (*Penstemon serrulatus*) P * There are many varieties that are non-native/invasive
- Stonecrop (*Sedum spathifolium*, *S. lanceolatum*, *S. oregonum*) P * The variation (*S. acre* is invasive)

Winter (Oct/Nov/Dec/Jan)

- Silk tassel plant (*Garrya elliptica*) S
- Evergreen huckleberry (*Vaccinium ovatum*) S
- Common snowberry (*Symphoricarpos albus*) S
- Tall and short, Oregon grape (*Mahonia aquifolium*, *M. nervosa*) (flower) S
- Salal (*Gaulthier shallon*) S
- Kinnickinick (*Arctostaphylos uva-ursi*) S
- Licorice fern (*Polypodium glycyrrhiza*) F
- Sword fern (*Polystichum munitum*) F
