Summary

Under the direct supervision of the Recreation Program Coordinator and Recreation Program Assistant, the position will be directly responsible for facilitating and integrating a child with physical or mental disabilities into the summer camp programs.

The applicant/incumbent will be required to undergo a criminal record check in order to work in this position and to report to their supervisor if any criminal charges are laid against them that may be related to their employment in this position.
