Summary

- Installs equipment, two way radios, emergency lighting, cellular telephones and D.C. Power conversion equipment.
- Welds and fabricates a variety of metals using electrical, arc and oxy-acetylene welding equipment, disk grinders, drills, band saws and other tools as required.
- Follows all policies, procedures and standards of the CRD
- Performs other related duties as required.
