Summary

Under the direct supervision of the Recreation Coordinator and under the guidance of the Team Leader, the Skate Instructor is responsible for planning and teaching skate lessons, supervising public skates and teaching various on-ice programs.

- Work cohesively with other instructors in group settings
- Maintain safe work practices
- Willingness and ability to work flexible hours including evenings, weekends (ability to work some daytime shifts an asset)
- Follows all policies, procedures and standards of the CRD.
- Performs other related duties as required.

- Successful completion of the Recreational Skating Instructors Course (or willingness to obtain) or a combination of equivalent experience.
- Experience with figure skating, ice skating or hockey
- Ability to teach hockey and/or skating to children and adults

- Ability to adapt to skill level of group
