A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A LOCAL SERVICE AREA WITHIN THE SOOKE ELECTORAL AREA OF THE  
CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES  
\*\*\*\*\*

WHEREAS, the Regional Board of the Capital Regional District, may, under Section 788(1)(g) of the Municipal Act, establish, and operate by by-law, a local service for the provision of fire prevention and suppression and the provision of assistance in response to other classes of circumstances specified by by-law that may cause harm to persons or property;

AND WHEREAS, the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities is required under Section 795(1)(a) of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS, the assent of the electors is required under Section 796 of the Municipal Act;

NOW THEREFORE, the Regional Board of the Capital Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The local service being established, and to be operated, is the provision of fire prevention and suppression services and attendance, in conjunction with police or ambulance service personnel, to provide assistance under their direction at emergency situations where harm may be caused to persons or property for that part of the Electoral Area of Sooke shown on the map attached hereto as Schedule "A".
2. The local service area which is to be established is to be known as the "Shirley Fire Protection Local Service Area."
3. The Capital Regional District may, by by-law, for the purpose of providing the local service, enter into contracts with the Shirley Volunteer Fire Protection Society.
4. The annual costs for the local service, net of grants and other revenue, shall be recovered:
  - (a) by a parcel tax to be imposed in the manner prescribed by Section 810.1(2) of the Municipal Act; and

- (b) any deficiency arising from a shortage of revenue generated by (a) by the requisition of money under Section 809.1 of the Municipal Act to be levied and collected under Section 810.1 of the Municipal Act.
- 5. The maximum amount of money that may be requisitioned under Section 804(1) for the local service will be the greater of:
  - (a) Eighteen Thousand Two Hundred (\$18,200.00) Dollars OR
  - (b) An amount equal to the amount that could be raised by a property value tax rate of \$1.31 per One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars which, when applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements within the local service area, will yield the maximum amount that may be requisitioned under Section 804(1)(a) and (b) for the service.
- 6. The Electoral Area of Sooke includes the participating area for this local service.
- 7. This By-law may be cited as "Shirley Fire Protection Local Services By-law No. 1, 1991".



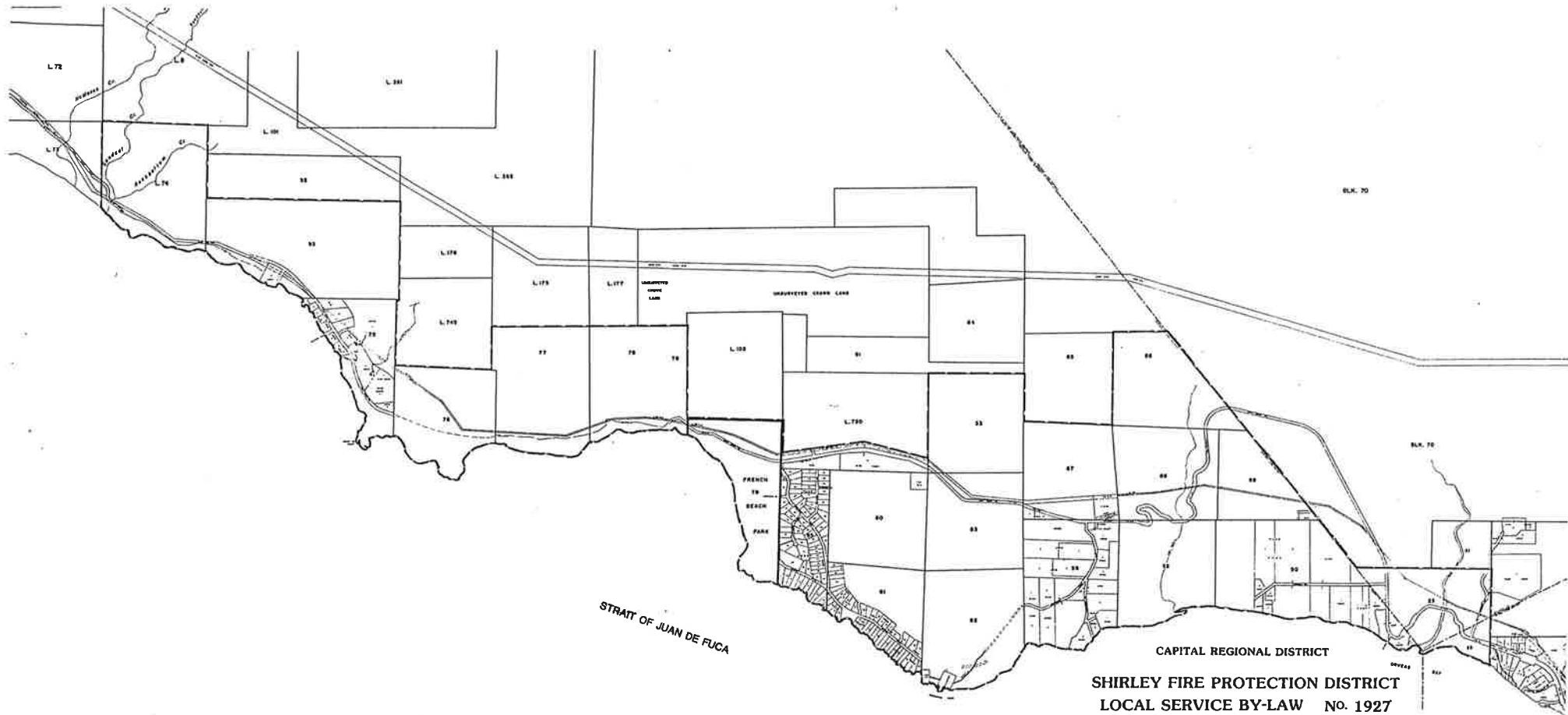

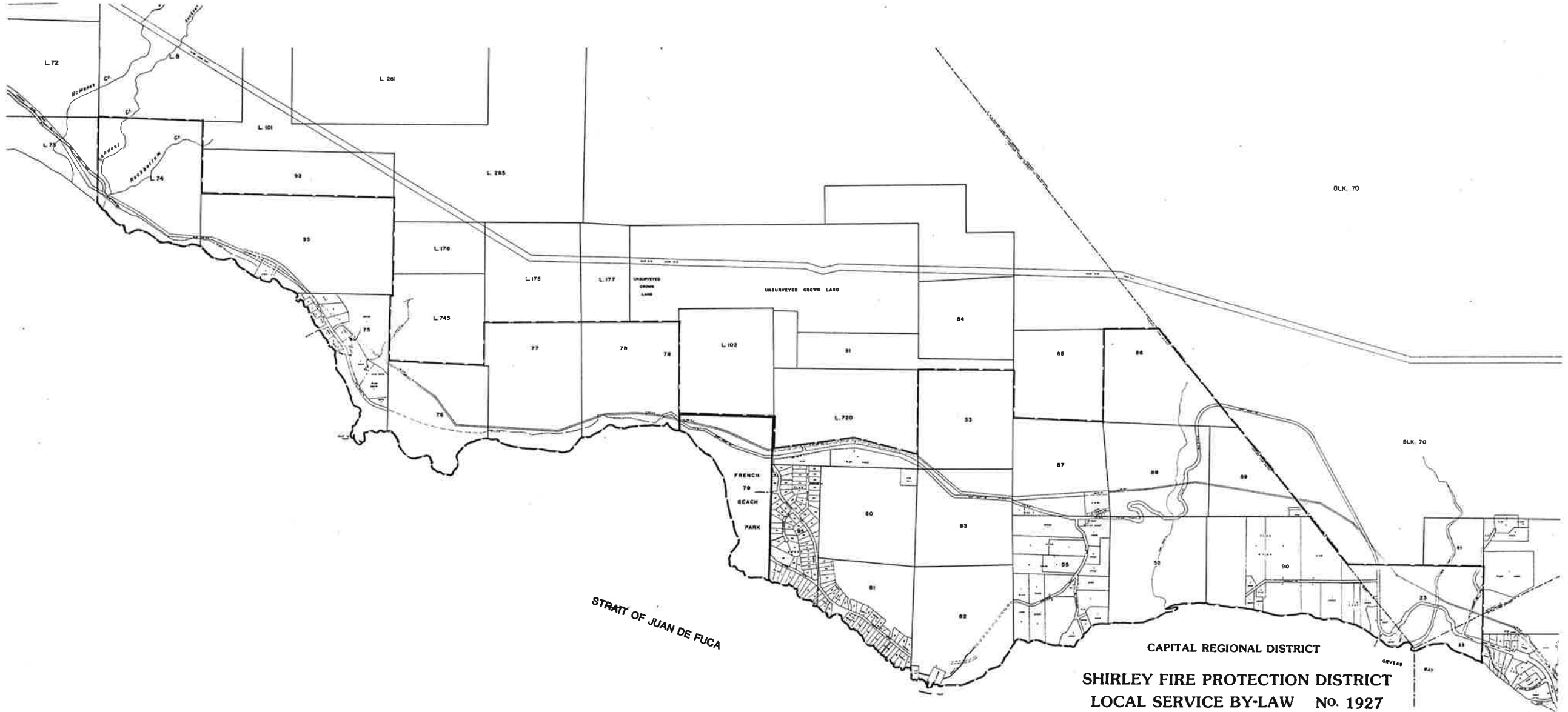
STRAIT OF JUAN DE FUCA
