BY-LAW NO. 1959

A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A LOCAL SERVICE AREA WITHIN THE LANGFORD ELECTORAL AREA OF THE CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Regional Board of the Capital Regional District, may, under Section 788(1)(j) of the <u>Municipal Act</u>, establish, and operate by by-law, the service of contributing to the costs of fire prevention and suppression and the provision of assistance in response to other classes of circumstances that is provided within the service area by another person or association;

AND WHEREAS, the Letters Patent for the Town of View Royal provide that the portion of the View Royal Fire Protection District lying outside of the Town of View Royal be declared a specified area of the Capital Regional District for the purposes of fire protection effective midnight December 31, 1991;

NOW THEREFORE, the Regional Board of the Capital Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. The function of contribution to the cost of Fire Prevention and suppression services and attendance, in conjunction with police or ambulance service personnel, to provide assistance under their direction at emergency situations where harm may be caused to person or property is hereby established as a local service.
- 2. The boundaries of the local service area shall be that part of the Electoral Area of Langford shown on the map attached to this by-law as Schedule "A".
- 3. The local service area shall be known as the "View Royal Fire Protection Local Service Area."
- 4. The Electoral Area of Langford includes the participating area for this service.
- 5. The Capital Regional District may, by by-law, for the purpose of providing Fire Prevention Suppression inside the local service area, enter into contracts with the Town of View Royal.
- 6. The annual costs for the local service, after deduction of grants and other revenue, shall be recovered as follows:
 - (a) Firstly, by a parcel tax to be imposed in the manner prescribed by Section 810.1(2) to the <u>Municipal Act</u>;
 - (b) In the case of any deficiency arising from a shortage of revenue generated under Subsection (a) by the requisition of money under Section 809.1 of the Municipal Act to be levied and collected under Section 810.1 of the Municipal Act.

- 7. The maximum amount of money that may be requisitioned under Section 804(1) of the Municipal Act for the local service will be the greater of:
 - One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000,00) (a)

OR

- An amount equal to the amount that could be raised by a property value tax rate of \$3.30 per One (b) Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars which, when applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements within the local service area, will yield the maximum amount that may be requisitioned under Section 804(1)(a) and (b) of the Municipal Act for the service.
- 8. This By-law may be cited as "View Royal Fire Protection Local Services By-law No. 1, 1991".
