**BYLAW NO. 3733**

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**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 3447 "CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT EMERGENCY  
MANAGEMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2007"**  
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The Board of the Capital Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 3447 "Capital Regional District Emergency Management Bylaw No. 1, 2007," is amended as follows:
  - a) By deleting the definition of "Electoral Area Emergency Management Commission" and "Electoral Area Emergency Operations Committee" in Section 1 Interpretation and Definitions, 1.2 (g) and (h) and then renumbering 1.2 (i) – (n) as 1.2 (g) – (l).
  - b) By deleting from the definition of "Electoral Area Emergency Coordinator", the words "as the local Deputy to the Emergency Manager" and replacing with the words "to coordinate emergency planning and response in the Electoral Area".
  - c) By deleting Section 2.1 (c) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

"(c) heads of the Capital Regional District departments or their alternates; and"
  - d) By deleting the words "Electoral Area Emergency Management Commissions," from Section 2.3 (e).
  - e) By deleting Section 2.4 (b) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

"(b) selected Capital Regional District staff or others as appointed by the Chief Administrative Officer."
  - f) By deleting Section 2.4 (c) in its entirety.
  - g) By deleting the sentence "Electoral Area Emergency Operations Committee or other persons as necessary in the event of an emergency." from Section 2.5 and renumbering it as 2.4 (c).
  - h) By deleting Sections 2.6 and 2.8 in their entirety and then renumbering Sections 2.7 and 2.9 to 2.5 and 2.6, respectively.
  - i) By changing the word "alternate" in Sections 2.5 and 3.2 to "Deputy"
  - j) By removing the sentence "The Board, the Board Chairperson, the Chief Administrative Officer or the Emergency Manager may, whether or not a state of local emergency has been declared, cause the Plan to be implemented where the Board, the Board Chairperson, the Chief Administrative Officer, or the Emergency Manager is of the opinion that an emergency exists or appears

imminent or a disaster has occurred or threatens in the Plan Area." from Section 4.1 (b), and inserting this sentence as Section 4.1 and renumbering Sections 4.1 to 4.5 as 4.2 to 4.6, respectively.

2. Citation

This bylaw may be cited as "Capital Regional District Emergency Management Bylaw No. 1, 2007, Amendment Bylaw No. 1, 2010."
