

**CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT
BYLAW NO. 2834**

**A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 2402, "SOURCE CONTROL
LOCAL SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 1996"**

WHEREAS:

- A. Under Bylaw 2402, "Source Control Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 1996", the Regional Board established a local service for the control of the direct or indirect discharge of contaminants into or through facilities connected to sewage facilities under the regulatory authority of the Capital Regional District;
- B. The Regional Board wishes to amend establishment Bylaw 2402, under Section 802 (1) (a) of *Local Government Act* , for the purpose of increasing the maximum requisition to provide for an Enhanced Source Control Program;
- C. the Regional Board, under Section 801(2)(b) of the *Local Government Act*, has passed a resolution by two-thirds of the votes cast to permit assent to be given by electors in the entire service area;
- D. the Regional Board has obtained the assent of the electors by counter petition, under Section 801.3 of the *Local Government Act*.

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Capital Regional District in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw No. 2402, "Source Control Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 1996" is hereby amended by:
 - (A) deleting Section 6 and replacing it with the following:
 - "6. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned under Section 803(1) of the *Local Government Act* for the local service shall be the greater of:
 - (a) one million one hundred thousand (\$1,100,000) ; or
 - (b) an amount equal to the amount that could be raised by a property value tax of \$0.037 per thousand (\$1,000) dollars which, when applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements within the local service area, will yield the maximum amount that may be requisitioned under Sections 803(1)(a) and (b) for the local service."
- 2. This bylaw may be cited as "Source Control Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 1996, Amendment Bylaw No. 1, 2001".
