BY-LAW NO. 1749

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AN EXTENDED SERVICE OF REGIONAL PARKS FOR ALL OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT, EXCEPT THE ELECTORAL AREA OF SALTSRING ISLAND FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING REGIONAL PARKS.

WHEREAS by Letters Patent Division III, the Regional District was granted the function of the acquisition, development, operation and maintenance of Regional Parks under the Park (Regional) Act.

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Capital Regional District is desirous of exercising the function granted to it by the Letters Patent in accordance with Part 24 of the Municipal Act subject to all the terms and conditions contained in the Letters Patent and including all the powers granted by the Letters Patent.

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board is desirous of proceeding under Section 767 of the Municipal Act to by bylaw under Section 767(4) and 794 of the Municipal Act establish the service as an extended service.

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board has obtained the consent of at least two thirds of the participants as required under Section 802(1)(b) of the Municipal Act.

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Capital Regional District in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Extended Service being established and to be operated; subject to the Park (Regional Act) is, Regional Parks.
2. The Extended Service Area is contained within the boundaries of all the Municipalities and Electoral Areas in the Capital Regional District, excluding the Electoral Area of Saltspring Island.
3. The Electoral Areas of Langford, Sooke and Outer Gulf Islands and the municipalities of North Saanich, Sidney, Central Saanich, Saanich, Victoria, Oak Bay, Esquimalt, View Royal, Colwood and Metchosin, include the participating areas for this Extended Service.
4. The annual operating and debt servicing costs for the Extended Service, net of grants and other revenue, shall be recovered by the requisition of money under Section 809 and 809.1 of the Municipal Act, to be collected by a property value tax in the Extended Service Area, to be levied and collected under Section 810(1) and 810.1(1).
5. This Bylaw may be cited as "Regional Parks Extended Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1, 1989".

CONSENTED TO by at least two-thirds of the Electoral Area Directors of Langford, Sooke and Outer Gulf Islands and the municipalities of North Saanich, Sidney, Central Saanich, Saanich, Victoria, Oak Bay, Esquimalt, View Royal, Colwood and Metchosin.
