**SUBJECT**     **PENDER ISLANDS PARKS COMMISSION BYLAW**

**PURPOSE/ISSUE**

The purpose of this report is to recommend to the Board adoption of Pender Islands Parks Commission Bylaw No. 3522.

**HISTORY/BACKGROUND**

The Capital Regional District Board at their September 12th meeting approved committee recommendations to standardize the electoral area parks and recreation commission bylaws. The electoral area bylaws were repealed and rewritten to standardize the format being joint parks and recreation. The Pender Islands are unique in the CRD having two separate commissions, one for recreation and one for parks, rather than one combined commission. The authority for recreation was inadvertently included in the parks bylaw and needs to be removed.
