SUBJECT CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT BYLAW AMENDMENT - AMENDMENT BYLAW 3556

PURPOSE

To amend Capital Regional District (CRD) Salt Spring Island Community Transit and Transportation Commission Bylaw No. 1, 2007 (Bylaw 3450) by renaming the commission and making minor amendments and housekeeping changes.

BACKGROUND

The amendment bylaw, Bylaw 3556, "Salt Spring Island Transportation Bylaw No. 1, 2007, Amendment Bylaw No. 1, 2008", is attached as Appendix A. The changes to the Salt Spring Island Transportation Bylaw are outlined below:

- delete the definition of "Commission" in Section 1 Definitions and replacing it
- deleting Section 2 Membership in its entirety and replacing it
- deleting Section 10 Citation in its entirety and replacing it
