**REPORT TO ELECTORAL AREA SERVICES COMMITTEE
MEETING OF WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 6, 2010**

SUBJECT: Repeal of Bylaws No. 278, 1407 and 2484 enacted for commissions that are no longer required

ISSUE:

The following bylaws should be repealed as they relate to commissions that are no longer required:

- No. 278, "View Royal Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1976"
- No. 1407, "Langford Economic Development Commission Bylaw, 1986"
- No. 2484, "Juan de Fuca Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1997"

BACKGROUND:

In addition to keeping the bylaw database current, repealing the bylaws listed above is justified as follows:

- No. 278, "View Royal Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1976" established a joint parks and recreation commission known as the View Royal Parks and Recreation Commission. As View Royal incorporated in 1988, this commission is no longer required.
- No. 1407, "Langford Economic Development Commission Bylaw, 1986" established an economic development commission, known as the Langford Economic Development Commission. As Langford incorporated in 1992, this commission is no longer required.
- No. 2484, "Juan de Fuca Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1997" was established to continue a joint parks and recreation commission service known as the Juan de Fuca Parks and Recreation Commission (West Shore). As the West Shore Parks and Recreation Society is now responsible for this service, bylaw 2484, "Juan de Fuca Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1997" is no longer required.

ALTERNATIVES:

1. That bylaw No. 3728 cited as "Bylaw to Repeal Bylaws No. 278, "View Royal Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1976", No. 1407, "Langford Economic Development Commission Bylaw, 1986" and No. 2484, "Juan de Fuca Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1997", 2010" be introduced and read a first time, read a second time, read a third time and adopted.
2. That bylaws No. 278, 1407, and 2484 not be repealed.

IMPLICATIONS:

Repealing the three bylaws (278, 1407, 2484) will help keep the bylaw database current and will not affect operations or financial resources.

CONCLUSION:

As the three bylaws noted below were enacted to create commissions that are no longer required, these bylaws should be repealed.

- No. 278, "View Royal Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1976"
- No. 1407, "Langford Economic Development Commission Bylaw, 1986"
- No. 2484, "Juan de Fuca Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1997"

RECOMMENDATION:

That bylaw No. 3728 cited as "Bylaw to Repeal Bylaws No. 278, "View Royal Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1976", No. 1407, "Langford Economic Development Commission Bylaw, 1986" and No. 2484, "Juan de Fuca Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw, 1997", 2010" be introduced and read a first time, read a second time, read a third time and adopted.
