

# REPORT TO THE ELECTORAL AREA SERVICES COMMITTEE MEETING OF TUESDAY, MARCH 21, 2012

#### **SUBJECT**

AMENDMENT TO BYLAW NO. 3064, A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION FOR THE JUAN DE FUCA ELECTORAL AREA (AMENDING BYLAW NO. 3815)

#### **ISSUE**

The Juan de Fuca Economic Development Commission (EDC) is proposing to change the commission meeting requirements.

#### **BACKGROUND**

In December 2011, the Electoral Area Director met with the EDC members to discuss the 2012 Commission activities. At that meeting it was decided that due to the economic downturn it would be more effective to have two meetings per year to consider funding applications. It was proposed that in spring and fall, a call for funding proposals would be circulated within the community and advertised locally. However, the existing Bylaw No. 3064 requires that the Commission meet six times per year. Staff has prepared a proposed amendment to the bylaw to provide flexibility to the EDC in determining the number of meetings held each year (Appendix 1).

#### **ALTERNATIVES**

- 1. To approve Bylaw No. 3815, "Juan de Fuca Economic Development Commission Bylaw, 2003, Amendment Bylaw No. 2, 2012" to amend Bylaw 3064.
- 2. To not amend Bylaw 3064.

### **PUBLIC CONSULTATION IMPLICATIONS**

This is an administrative bylaw and therefore does not require public consultation. However, staff has consulted with the Electoral Area Director and discussed the implications of the amendment.

#### **CONCLUSIONS**

The EDC would like to consider funding applications at two meetings per year. However, the existing bylaw requires that the Commission meet six times per year. Staff has proposed an amendment to the bylaw that allows for flexibility in the number of meetings required annually.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That the Electoral Area Services Committee recommends to the Capital Regional District Board:

- 1. That Bylaw No. 3815, "Juan de Fuca Economic Development Commission Bylaw, 2003, Amendment Bylaw No. 2, 2012" be introduced and read a first time and a second time;
- 2. That Bylaw No. 3815, "Juan de Fuca Economic Development Commission Bylaw, 2003, Amendment Bylaw No. 2, 2012" be read a third time; and
- 3. That Bylaw No. 3815, "Juan de Fuca Economic Development Commission Bylaw, 2003, Amendment Bylaw No. 2, 2012" be adopted.
