

REPORT TO GANGES SEWER LOCAL SERVICE COMMISSION MEETING OF MONDAY 26 JULY 2010

SUBJECT

REQUESTS FOR INCLUSION OF PROPERTY IN THE GANGES SEWERAGE LOCAL SERVICE AREA

ISSUE

The owners of two parcels of land located adjacent to the Ganges Sewerage Local Service Area (GSLSA) have requested inclusion in the GSLSA in order to receive sewer service. Provision of service to the parcels is contingent upon amendment of the establishment bylaw for the Ganges Sewerage Local Service.

BACKGROUND

On August 24, 2009, the Ganges Sewer Local Services Commission (GSLSC) supported a request by the Salt Spring and Southern Gulf Islands Community Services Society, subject to payment of applicable fees, to include Parcel No. 1 (DD 97462I) of Parcel L (DD 37318I), Sections 19 and 20, Range 4 East, North Salt Spring Island (628 Fulford-Ganges Road), in the Ganges Sewer service area. The society has since paid the applicable capacity purchase charge in accordance with Bylaw No. 3262, "Ganges Sewerage Service Capacity Purchase Charge Bylaw No. 1, 2005", and the estimated connection charge in accordance with Bylaw No. 1922, "Ganges Sewerage Local Service Area Fee and Charge Bylaw No. 1, 1991".

Gulf Islands School District No. 64 has requested inclusion of Lot C, Plan VIP 3995, Section 2, Range 3E, portion North Salt Spring (240 Rainbow Road) in the Ganges sewer area, and has agreed to pay the applicable capacity purchase and estimated connection charges (Attachment 1).

In order to include the two properties, Bylaw No. 3704, a Bylaw to Amend Bylaw No. 1923, Salt Spring Island Ganges Sewage Local Service Establishment Bylaw, 1991 has been prepared (Attachment 2).

ALTERNATIVES

- That the Ganges Sewer Local Service Commission recommend to the CRD Board that Bylaw No. 3704, "A Bylaw to Amend Bylaw No. 1923, Salt Spring Island Ganges Sewerage Local Establishment Bylaw, 1991" be introduced, and read a first time, read a second time and read a third time.
- That the Ganges Sewer Local Service Commission receive this report and request further information from staff.

IMPLICATIONS

There will be no immediate cost to the existing participants in the Ganges Sewerage Local Service resulting from inclusion of either property. There is sufficient capacity in the Ganges sewer infrastructure to receive the expected volume of wastewater discharge from both properties based on current zoning and use, based on a capacity study completed in 2009. The capacity purchase charges levied upon inclusion provide reasonable compensation to the current service area participants for redistribution of available sewage collection, treatment and outfall capacity to include the two additional properties. Both applicants for inclusion have demonstrated a need for sewer service in order to minimize adverse impacts of aging onsite wastewater systems on public health and the environment. Both applicants provide services or amenities to the community.

CONCLUSION

The inclusion of Parcel No. 1 (DD 97462I) of Parcel L (DD 37318I), Sections 19 and 20, Range 4 East, North Salt Spring Island (628 Fulford-Ganges Road) and Lot C, Plan VIP 3995, Section 2, Range 3E, portion North Salt Spring (240 Rainbow Road) in the Ganges Sewerage Local Service Area will benefit the applicants (Southern Gulf Islands Community Services Society, and Gulf Island School District, respectively) and the community they serve. The conditions of inclusion have been met, and inclusion will not adversely impact the existing participants in the service.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Ganges Sewer Local Service Commission recommend to the CRD Board that Bylaw No. 3704, "A Bylaw to Amend Bylaw No. 1923, Salt Spring Island Ganges Sewerage Local Establishment Bylaw, 1991" be introduced, and read a first time, read a second time and read a third time.

School District 64 is in the process of occupying the residence located on the above mentioned parcel for the purposes of operating an educational alternate program which is associated with Gulf Islands Secondary School, the original residence will stay on the property and serve as an office, washroom and congregation area for the program. As this is an older property the septic system while still operational, does not meet a standard which we expect for an institutional occupancy, it is for this reason we would request that the Ganges Sewer Commission consider our request for a connection to the sewer system.

In response to the questions asked in your letter to the School District;
1 - Re present zoning of property and the number of residences.

- The property is presently zoned A1 which allows for a single family dwelling and other farm related uses, we anticipate that the site will be re zoned to CF1 at some time in the future which will bring it in line with the Gulf Islands Secondary site zoning.
- 2 Subdivision potential
 - This property is in the Agricultural Land Reserve, we are presently
 in the process of gaining permission for the property to be used for
 educational purposes, the Agricultural Land Commission has granted
 permission for this amendment to take place with the proviso that
 the property be amalgamated with the Gulf Islands Secondary School
 Site which is immediately adjacent.
