**ERRATA for the Home and Community Care Staff Report
presented July 20, 2005**

The July 20, 2005 Committee Report on Home and Community Care contains an error.

Under Background, Section 1 (Decline in the over 75 population), a second look at the population forecasts show that the use of an aggregate over 75 population rate of use (92.5 spaces per 1,000 population) results in slightly higher expected residents of residential care and assisted living compared with the more detailed age group calculations. The conclusion that VIHA is potentially underestimating needed spaces by 9% or approximately 200 spaces is incorrect. The aggregate over 75 population measure appears to have an approximate 3% (3016 versus 2929 or 87 spaces) higher estimate of residential care and assisted living to 2010 than the detailed age group calculations.
