

Sooke Basin

This line represents the area RCM-SAR is proposing to use for non-farming purposes. This area has not been farmed in over 50 years. There is a 9 m buffer zone within the area that is populated with fruit trees that we will continue to harvest. RCM-SAR is researching the best uses for the farm land. The possibilities include community gardens or leasing portions to individual or commercial farmers.

* West Neighbour: Farms Xmas Trees

Dormant Fields: land hasn't been worked for more than 60 years, 13 acres RCM-SAR will attempt to farm these areas

Cabin: built in 1920's 800sq ft

Spring: will use water for agricultural purposes

Tennis Courts: Cement

Cabin: built in 1901 800sq ft

Cabins: 13 all the same size approximately 150sq ft plus 2 larger cabins 200sq ft these all date back to the 1930's as part of the resort operations

* East Neighbour: Private Property no house

Lodge: Built in 1911, a large facility was the original home. It became the focal point for the use of the property, first as a large resort that operated on the property for many years secondly as the Sisters of St. Ann activities centre, 7000sq ft.

Recreation Hall/Barn: Unsafe torn down 4800sq ft.

Workshop: Built in 2006, 800sq ft

Well Water: poor wells in this area, no CRD water line, RCM-SAR will investigate bringing the water line to the property

Garage: built in 1980's 400sq ft

Greenhouse: Plastic covered wood structure in poor condition

Dormant Field: not farmed in over 60 years, will attempt to farm it 3 acres

* Sisters of St. Ann still own these 2 properties

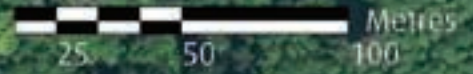
