My reason(s) for appearing (is/are) and the substance of my presentation is as follows::
Rocky Point Bird Observatory (RPBO) participates in a variety of bird and bird conservation issues on southern Vancouver Island. RPBO directly runs 3 bird monitoring programs, one for breeding bird productivity and survival and two fall migration monitoring stations at Pedder Bay and Rocky Point (DND lands). It also participates in a Purple Martin nesting and monitoring program, a hummingbird monitoring program, and assorted bird research projects. Our membership of about 150 people primarily reside in the CRD area. RPBO is concerned about bird conservation issues at Island View, including illegal dog disturbance of fall, winter and spring birds. It is also concerned about the ongoing disturbance to natural ecosystems by invasive plants and people and management activities that decrease ecological value by interfering with water regimes.
