Delegation: Tony Wass, Lochside Trail Riders, Re: Item 5.2 - Regional Trails Management Plan

Mr. Tony Wass spoke regarding the Lochside Trail and requested a change in the wording of Alternative 1 in Staff Report 5.2 as follows: "That the regional parks committee receive this report for information and direct staff to investigate options for multi-use on the unpaved sections of the Lochside Trail between Centennial Trail and Island View Beach Road and report back on those options in the fall." He presented his concerns and requested that all sections of the trail that are rural, stay rural.

Dr. Barbara Powell spoke against the Island View Beach Regional Park Draft Management Plan and lack of benefits in the plan. She stated that the plan is disproportionately allocated and feels it is impossible to implement.
