SUBJECT:

Overview to Regional Planning Services Department and Goals for 2003

BACKGROUND:

On Saturday, January 11, 2003 members of the Board and alternates received an orientation to the Capital Regional District at Dunsmuir Lodge. The orientation manual included information on Regional Planning Services (RPS) Department and a brief presentation was given on the Department.

Attachment A is a copy of the summary information on RPS distributed to the Board at the orientation session.

DISCUSSION:

As noted in Attachment A, RPS is a small department that delivers three programs: Regional Information Service, Regional Transportation Planning, and Regional Growth Strategy. I will give a more in depth verbal presentation than that given at the Board orientation to the roles and responsibilities of the department, to give committee members a good understanding of RPS and provide the opportunity for questions.

The presentation will conclude with a discussion of the department's goals for 2003. Detailed discussion of the 2003 Work Plan and Budget is scheduled for the February 19th meeting.
