



**REPORT TO REGIONAL WATER SUPPLY COMMISSION  
MEETING OF WEDNESDAY, 18 MAY 2011**

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**SUBJECT**      **TRANSMISSION MAIN NO. 15, PAVEMENT RESTORATION PROJECT AT SOOKE  
POTHoles (REF. No. 2011-492) – AWARD OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT**

**ISSUE**

To recommend the award of a contract to Capital City Paving Ltd. for the restoration of the Sooke Potholes Regional Park road.

**BACKGROUND**

The recently constructed and commissioned transmission main servicing Sooke (Transmission Main No. 15) was constructed through the Capital Regional District (CRD) Sooke Potholes Regional Park. The park road experienced deterioration due to pipe installation activities and delivery of materials. In March of 2011, the CRD prepared a design and issued a tender for road restoration work of approximately 1,200 m within the park.

The proposed work was publicly tendered and four tenders were received by the tender closing on March 29, 2011. They are summarized as follows:

<b>Tenderer</b>	<b>Total Tendered Amount (including HST)</b>
1. Capital City Paving Ltd.	\$233,889.60
2. Island Asphalt Co.	\$240,044.90
3. Van-Isle Blacktop Ltd.	\$294,560.00
4. Jacob Bros. Construction Ltd.	\$301,705.60

The lowest eligible tender was submitted by Capital City Paving Ltd. of Victoria. Capital City Paving Ltd. is known to the CRD staff and they are deemed capable of completing the project.

**ALTERNATIVES**

1. Award the contract to Capital City Paving Ltd.
2. Award the contract to another tenderer.

**FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

Alternative 1

Award the contract to Capital City Paving Ltd. for \$233,889.60, which is within the budget amount for this phase of the overall project.

Alternative 2

Awarding the contract to one of the other bidders without a valid reason increases the cost of construction, and likely would result in legal action by the low bidder.

**SUMMARY**

In summary, the tender received from Capital City Paving Ltd. for \$233,889.60 meets the terms of the tender and project budget and it is recommended that Capital City Paving Ltd. be awarded the contract for the work.

**RECOMMENDATION**

That the Regional Water Supply Commission award a construction contract to Capital City Paving Ltd. in the amount of \$233,889.60 (including HST) for the Transmission Main No. 15, Pavement Restoration Project at Sooke Potholes Regional Park.

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
