TO ALL CONTRACTORS AND TENDERERS:

This letter shall serve as confirmation that the revisions included herein as Addendum No. 2 shall form part of the Contract Documents for Contract 20.21.03-01.

ADDENDUM NO.2

Revise the Contract Documents as follows:

General Condition 55: Insurance

Delete:

Commercial General Liability

Commercial General Liability Insurance acceptable to the Owner with limits of liability of not less than FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000.00) inclusive, for bodily injury and property damage for any one occurrence or series of occurrences arising out of one cause and not less than FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000.00) for personal injury.

The insurance shall be in the joint names of the Contractor, the Owner and the Owner's Consultant (McElhanny).

The Commercial General Liability Insurance shall include but not necessarily be limited to the following coverage:

- (a) Premises and operations liability;
- (b) Products and completed operations liability;
- (c) Blanket contractual liability;
- (d) Bodily injury and property damage on an "occurrence" basis;
- (e) "All Risk" property damage including the loss of use of property;
- (f) Owner's and Contractor's protective liability;
- (g) Elevator and hoist liability;
- (h) Contingent employer's liability;
- (i) Personal injury liability arising out of false arrest, detention or imprisonment or malicious prosecution; libel, slander or defamation of character; invasion of privacy, wrongful eviction or wrongful entry;
- (j) Shoring, blasting, excavating, underpinning, demolition, pile driving and caisson work, work below ground surface, tunnelling and grading, as applicable; and
- (k) Cross liability or severability of interest clause.

The insurance shall continue for a period of at least ONE (1) YEAR beyond the date of the Owner's Notice of Acceptance for the completed operations hazard.

ADD:

Commercial General Liability

Commercial General Liability Insurance acceptable to the Owner with limits of liability of not less than FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000.00) inclusive, for bodily injury and property damage for any one occurrence or series of occurrences arising out of one cause and not less than FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$5,000,000.00) for personal injury.

The insurance shall be in the joint names of the Contractor, the Owner, District of Saanich, and the Owner's Consultant (McElhanny).

The Commercial General Liability Insurance shall include but not necessarily be limited to the following coverage:

- (l) Premises and operations liability;
- (m) Products and completed operations liability;
- (n) Blanket contractual liability;
- (o) Bodily injury and property damage on an "occurrence" basis;
- (p) "All Risk" property damage including the loss of use of property;
- (q) Owner's and Contractor's protective liability;
- (r) Elevator and hoist liability;
- (s) Contingent employer's liability;
- (t) Personal injury liability arising out of false arrest, detention or imprisonment or malicious prosecution; libel, slander or defamation of character; invasion of privacy, wrongful eviction or wrongful entry;
- (u) Shoring, blasting, excavating, underpinning, demolition, pile driving and caisson work, work below ground surface, tunnelling and grading, as applicable; and
- (v) Cross liability or severability of interest clause.

The insurance shall continue for a period of at least ONE (1) YEAR beyond the date of the Owner's Notice of Acceptance for the completed operations hazard

All Tenderers shall acknowledge receipt and acceptance of this Addendum No. 1 by signing and dating in the spaces provided below and submitting the signed Addendum with the Tender. Tenders submitted without this Addendum may be considered incomplete.
