#### Caledonia – Working Towards a Public Hearing

### When is the Public Hearing?

While we do not have a formal date, we are hoping for early 2021. When a date has formally been announced, we will post it on our <u>Caledonia Project Webpage</u>.

#### About Caledonia

The Caledonia redevelopment proposal is a mixed-market community located in central Fernwood. The project has been designed to address the City of Victoria's strategic priorities of increasing affordable housing, strong, livable neighborhoods, sustainable transportation, climate leadership and health, well-being and a welcoming city.

Caledonia will replace the existing Capital Region Housing Corporation's (CRHC) townhomes, with 158 affordable rental units across two apartment buildings and three townhouse buildings. This includes 14 studios, 45 one bedrooms, 77 two bedrooms, 14 three bedrooms and 8 four bedrooms. Of that amount, 15 units will be accessible and 32 will be provided through the <u>Community Housing Fund</u> program at provincial assistance rates of \$375 per month for a studio or one-bedroom, and \$570 per month for a two-bedroom.

Surrounding greenspaces and parks are protected for future generations, including the existing Fernwood Community Allotment Gardens. Additionally, landscape plans have incorporated rain gardens, allotment gardens and public pathway networks within the nearly 60% open site space on the Caledonia development. In consultation with the Compost Education Centre and the Fernwood Community Allotment Gardens, the urban agricultural space will remain a vibrant community amenity.

The Caledonia proposal represents how multiple levels of government can partner to create a much needed, affordable, sustainable and family-minded project. It also demonstrates that by working with the community from the onset, healthy community growth can be realized.

As we all prepare for a very different approach to the holidays, we wish you, your family and friends a safe and healthy holiday season, and refreshing start to the New Year.
