Re: Capital Regional District - Jordan River Lands

This letter is to update you on the developments since our previous letter of December 18, 2014 regarding our seismic hazard study, the Jordan River Diversion Dam and potential implications for downstream interests.

As a result of discussions with the Capital Regional District and new information provided by a third-party risk assessment expert, we are now in a position to support overnight camping on land owned by the District within the evacuation area.

We are prepared to commit \$150,000 towards the cost of an emergency alarm or siren system on the basis that the Capital Regional District will pay for its installation and maintenance.

We are continuing our discussions with the District for the purchase of the District's non-waterfront lands in the evacuation area and the acquisition of a restrictive covenant prohibiting future residential development on the waterfront lands within the evacuation area.
