Safety Plan and Rules for the Pottery Studio

To maintain the safety of patrons and staff and prevent the spread of COVID-19, the pottery studio looks different. This includes the requirement for all participants to reserve their court in advance. Reservations allow us to ensure physical distancing is maintained and provide time for staff to perform additional cleaning.

As with all programs and services:

- **Stay home** if you are sick, have traveled out of the country in the past 14 days or if someone in your household is has a confirmed case of COVID-19
- Wash or sanitize your hands before, during and after your visit
- Follow physical distancing – stay 2 metres apart at all times (No congregating or socializing inside/outside the lobby, walkways, and or in the studio)
- Cover your cough and sneeze into your sleeve or tissue
- Masks are required at all times in the pottery studio including transitions/common spaces such as entrances, hallways, and lobby spaces
- To not arrive early or leave late to your scheduled activity

Pottery Studio:

- Please take a spray bottle with approved disinfectant for the duration of your session
- Clean equipment and surfaces before and after use including table surface, chair, and shared equipment such as pottery wheels, ware board and molds.
- Bring your own tools an specific supplies – avoid sharing
- Please leave enough time at the end of your session sanitize your work station, put all tools away and exit through the exterior door of the pottery studio. The next session starts immediately so please ensure you leave on time.
- Be patient and considerate of others.

Rules are subject to change and will be updated as needed. Those disregarding rules may be asked to leave the facility.
