Public Ticket Draw - Official Rules and Regulations  
North Saanich, BC

The North Saanich public draw consists of:

Part One: Two draws for tickets to the Kraft Hockeyville NHL® pre-season game between the Vancouver Canucks® and San Jose Sharks® scheduled to be held on Monday, September 21, 2015 at The Q Centre, West Shore Parks & Recreation, 1767 Island Hwy, Colwood, BC (the “Pre-Season Game”). One draw will be held for residents of the Saanich Peninsula and one draw for all other supporters..

Part Two: If an NHL® Team practice session occurs on Monday, September 21, 2015, at The Q Centre (the “Game Day Practice Session”) and is open to the public, two draws for tickets to the Game Day Practice Session will also be held from the base of the remaining ballots from Part One. One draw will be held for residents of the Saanich Peninsula, and one draw for all other supporters.

The draws for the Pre-Season Game and the draws for the Game Day Practice Session shall each occasionally be referred to hereinafter as a “Draw” and together as the “Draws”. The draws for residents of the Saanich Peninsula will be referred to hereinafter as the “Residents’ Draw” and the draws for all other supporters will be hereinafter referred to as the “Supporters’ Draw”.

1. Eligibility

The Residents’ Draws for Part One and Part Two are open to:

- a) Residents of District of North Saanich, District of Central Saanich & Town of Sidney (as determined by proof of residence) who are 19 years old and over on the date of entry, except immediate family members of the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee and the Partners (as defined as any person who lives with a committee member as a member of the committee member’s family).

The Supporters’ Draws for Part One and Part Two are open to:

- b) A limited number of tickets will be available in a separate draw for supporters from outside the Saanich Peninsula who are 19 years of age or over on the date of entry, except immediate family members of the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee (as defined as any person who lives with a committee member as a member of the committee member's family) and the Partners (as defined in Section 11) (the individuals described in the foregoing clauses (a), and (b) collectively, the "Eligible Entrants"). (This draw will be separate from the initial draw as described in clause (a).

Each Eligible Entrant may only submit one (1) ballot in either the ballot box marked for residents or for supporters, not both.

## 2. Entry Period

No purchase required.

- To enter, Eligible Entrants need to visit Panorama Recreation Centre at 1885 Forest Park Drive, North Saanich, BC to complete a ballot during one of the dates and times listed below.

Saturday, August 29, 2015 from 10 a.m. PST to 4 p.m. PST

Saturday, September 5, 2015 from 10 a.m. PST to 4 p.m. PST

Sunday, September 6, 2015 from 12 p.m. PST to 6 p.m. PST

- Eligible Entrants for Draw (a) in Section 1 (the Residents' Draw) must show, at the time of ballot submission, one (1) piece of documentation, with postal code, demonstrating that they are a resident of North Saanich, Central Saanich or Sidney and one (1) piece of photo documentation, demonstrating that they are a minimum of 19 years of age on the date of entry.

Eligible Entrants for Draw (b) in Section 1 (the Supporters' Draw) must show, at the time of ballot submission, one (1) piece of documentation, demonstrating that they are a minimum of 19 years of age on the date of entry.

- The ballot will require all Eligible Entrants to (1) - provide name, address, city/town, province, postal code, ten digit and evening telephone numbers, e-mail address and cell phone number, as applicable; and (2) correctly answer (unaided) a time-limited mathematical skill-testing question at the time of the ballot submission.

All entries must be received by 6 p.m. PST on Sunday, September 6, 2015. Only one (1) ballot per Eligible Entrant.

### 3. Number of Tickets Awarded

Part One: A total of 788 individual Pre-Season Game tickets will be available through the Residents' Draw for residents of North Saanich, Central Saanich and Sidney; and a total of 376 individual Pre-Season Game tickets will be available for the Supporters' Draw for supporters outside the immediate Saanich Peninsula area.

Part Two: A total of 540 individual Game Day Practice Session tickets will be available through the Residents' Draw for North Saanich, Central Saanich and Sidney residents, and a total of 200 individual Pre-Season Game tickets available for the Supporters' Draw for supporters outside the Saanich Peninsula, if the Game Day Practice Session is open to the public, as determined by the National Hockey League ("NHL") in its sole discretion.

### 4. Ticket Details

Part One: Each selected Eligible Entrant will receive two (2) tickets to the Pre-Season Game between the Vancouver Canucks® and San Jose Sharks®. There will be a total of 394 ballots selected for the Residents' Draw and a total of 188 ballots selected for the Supporters' Draw. All tickets must be accepted as awarded. All costs and incidental expenses related to the ticket holders' attendance at the Pre-Season Game shall be the sole responsibility of the ticket holder.

Part Two: Each selected Eligible Entrant will receive two (2) tickets to the Game Day Practice Session, if the Game Day Practice Session is open to the public. There will be a total of 270 ballots selected for the Residents' Draw and a total of 100 ballots selected for the Supporters' Draw. All tickets must be accepted as awarded. All costs and incidental expenses relating to the ticket holders' attendance at the Game Day Practice Session (if the same is open to the public) shall be the sole responsibility of the ticket holder.

### 5. Ticket Conditions

All tickets to the Pre-Season Game or the Game Day Practice Session (if open to the public) are provided at no cost to the ticket holder. No ticket(s) may be sold or auctioned (for monetary gain or otherwise), or used for any promotional or commercial purpose, or as prizing in any sweepstakes, drawing or giveaway (except, for clarity, by Panorama Recreation in connection with the present

Draw). Tickets are non-transferable. The tickets cannot be substituted or redeemed as cash. Should any tickets be sold or otherwise used in a manner non-compliant with these Official Rules and Regulations or the terms and conditions contained on such ticket(s), the ticket holder risks their ticket(s) being cancelled, without notice. If the Pre-Season Game and/or the Game Day Practice Session are cancelled for any reason, tickets will not be valid and no substitute tickets or other prizes will be awarded.

## 6. Official Draws

Part One: The official Draws for the Pre-Season Game tickets will be conducted at the Panorama Recreation Centre on Wednesday, September 9, 2015 between 3 p.m. PST and 5 p.m. PST.

Part Two: The official Draws for the Game Day Practice Session tickets (if the same will be made open to the public) will be conducted at Panorama Recreation Centre on Wednesday, September 9, 2015 following the draws for the Pre-Season Game tickets. For clarity, Eligible Entrants selected in the first draw for the Pre-Season Game will not be eligible for tickets to the Game Day Practice Session.

Each Draw will be supervised by the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee. Once all tickets have been allocated, the applicable Draw will be closed. For clarity, the Draw for tickets to the Game Day Practice Session will only take place if the Game Day Practice Session has been confirmed to be open to the public by the NHL.

## 7. List of Winners

A list of the Eligible Entrants selected to receive tickets, provided they have correctly answered the skill-testing question on the ballot, will be available on the Panorama Recreation website by 5pm PST, Thursday, September 10, 2015.

## 8. Claiming Tickets

Tickets can only be picked up at Panorama Recreation Centre at 1885 Forest Park Drive, North Saanich, BC, between 9 a.m. PST and 5 p.m. PST Saturday, September 12, 2015 or 9 a.m. PST and 3 p.m. PST Sunday, September 13, 2015. Winners must

show photo identification and will be required to sign for their tickets. No one other than the name listed on the selected ballot may pick up tickets. Any tickets that go unclaimed as of 3 p.m. PST Sunday, September 13, 2015 will be forfeited by the winner. Any tickets forfeited will be reallocated at the sole discretion of the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee.

#### 9. Chances of Winning

The chance of winning a pair of tickets to the Pre-Season Game or the Game Day Practice Session depends on the total number of eligible ballots received during the entry period.

#### 10. Ownership of Entries

All entries shall become the property of the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee and will not be acknowledged or returned.

#### 11. Release of Liability

The North Saanich Local Organizing Committee, the Capital Regional District, the NHL and its member clubs, NHL Enterprises, L.P., NHL Enterprises Canada, L.P., NHL Enterprises B.V., NHL Interactive CyberEnterprises, LLC, NHL Network US, L.P. and The NHL Network, Inc. (such NHL Entities, collectively, the "NHL Entities"), the National Hockey League Players Association ("NHLPA") and its members, Kraft and the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation ("CBC" and collectively with the NHL Entities, NHLPA and Kraft, the "Partners") assume no responsibility for late, lost, stolen, destroyed, misdirected, illegible or otherwise indecipherable entries or any combination thereof. By accepting the tickets, winner agrees to release and hold harmless the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee, the Capital Regional District and the Partners, and each of their respective directors, employees, members, officers, and agents from any and all liability, damage, loss or injury arising from the awarding, acceptance, use and/or misuse of the tickets, or from cancellation or non-occurrence of the Pre-Season Game and/or the Game Day Practice Session. For clarity, neither the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee nor each of the Partners shall be liable to any winner or any other person for failure to supply any ticket, for any reason that is beyond the sole control of the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee, including, without limitation, any acts of God; any action(s), regulation(s), order(s), or request(s) by any governmental or quasi-governmental; equipment failure; terrorist acts; earthquake; war; fire; flood; explosion; unusually severe weather; hurricane; embargo; labour dispute or strike (whether legal or illegal, and whether or not NHL-related); labour or material shortage; transportation interruption of any kind; work slow-down; civil disturbance; insurrection; or riot.

#### 12. Consent To Use of Personality

By accepting a prize in the Draw(s), the winners and their guests consent to the use of their name, city of residence, photograph, likeness, image or any other aspect of their personality, for any publicity and programming purposes, commercial or otherwise, in all media used by the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee and the Partners and their respective advertising and promotional agencies without payment or compensation.

#### 13. Consent To Collection, Use And Disclosure Of Personal Information

By entering the Draws, and voluntarily providing personal information including name, address, telephone number, cell number, and email address, each entrant grants permission to the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee to: (a) collect and use the entrant's information for the purpose of administering the Draws and contacting selected entrants; (b) Post a list of Eligible Entrant names selected to receive tickets on the arena concourse bulletin board at Panorama Recreation Centre, on the North Saanich Kraft Hockeyville 2015 facebook page and on the Panorama Recreation website, and (c) for any other purposes required or permitted by law.

#### 14. Miscellaneous

The Draws are subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. By entering the Draws, participants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and Regulations and all decisions of the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee and the Partners. Employees and families of employees of the Partners and the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee are not eligible to participate in the Draws.

Any decision of the North Saanich Local Organizing Committee made in relation to the Draws is final on all matters of fact, interpretation, eligibility, procedure and fulfillment in all matters related to this contest and without appeal.

The North Saanich Local Organizing Committee reserves the right to ask Eligible Entrants to confirm proof of age prior to awarding any tickets.

This contest is subject to the laws of the province of British Columbia and the laws of Canada applicable herein.

#### 15. Release of Partners

The Partners and each of their subsidiaries, affiliates, shareholders, officers, directors, agents, representatives and employees will have no liability or responsibility for any claim arising in connection with participation in the Draws. The Partners have not offered or sponsored the Draws in any way and are not involved in its operation or administration.
