Seasonal Safari Preschool – Kindergarten; 1 hr

Bring your little ones on a forest walk through the tall trees. Using keen 'knee-high' observation skills and fun activities we'll connect with nature and explore seasonal changes at this time of year. **Offered at Francis/King Regional Park.**

Going Squirrelly! Kindergarten – Grade 1; 1.5 hrs

This interactive program introduces children to tree squirrels, and the adaptations to their forest homes. Your students will experience the changing autumnal forest as these busy acrobats prepare for the winter ahead. **Offered at Francis/King Regional Park.**

Who's Hooting? Grades 1 – 2; 1.5 hrs

Students will discover the whoo-oo, what and how of these expert night hunters and their unique adaptations. A close-up look at two different species of common owls, practising some awesome owl calls and hands-on learning will round out the program. **Offered at Francis/King Regional Park.**

Spook-tacular Grades 1 – 4; 1.5 hrs

Join in the spook-tacular fun with your students as myths are revealed and dispelled about spiders, owls, bats and more as they stroll through the towering trees of an ancient forest. We'll fill the cauldron with spooky treasures from the natural world. **Offered at Francis/King Regional Park, October 21, 22, 23, 24, 28, 29, 30, 31.**

Ha-bat-itat Grades 2 – 3; 1.5 hrs

Bats have fascinated and intrigued people for centuries. Your students will explore and discover the special adaptations these unique flying mammals use to survive and the important role they play in the forest ecosystem. **Offered at Francis/King Regional Park.**

The heART of nature Grades 4 – 5; 1.5 hrs

Naturalists have long used journals to record information about the world around them. In this collaborative program, CRD and the Robert Bateman Centre encourage students to connect to the park through observation, inquiry and sketching to draw a deeper connection with nature. Cougars! Grades 4 – 5; 1.5 hrs

Elusive and mysterious, cougars are at the top of the food chain!
