

## Idyllic West Coast Beauty

Jordan River Regional Park Campground offers a self-contained camping experience in a 187 hectare mixed coastal forest.

### Park Features

- 3.5 km of cobble beach along the Strait of Juan de Fuca
- fabulous views of the Olympic Peninsula
- Sandcut Beach, a local favorite day-use area
- trails through coastal hemlock and cedar forest

### Campground

**The campground operates year-round on a first-come first-served basis. There are no online or phone reservations.**

### Fees

Apr 1 - Oct 31 \$15/night. Additional vehicle \$5/night.  
Nov 1 - Mar 31 \$10/night. Additional vehicle \$5/night.  
Payable by cash only. Fees include taxes.

### Facilities and Services

The campground has drive-in sites and walk-in sites. Campsites are self-contained. The campground provides:

- waterfront views
- public garbage bins
- pit toilets
- drinking water station
- picnic areas
- individual fire rings

The campground does not provide hydro, dumping station and showers. Cellular phone service is limited.

### Campground and Park Rules

- Quiet time 10pm to 8am
- Generator use permitted 9-11am and 6-8pm
- Checkout by 11am
- Maximum length of stay 14 days per calendar year



- No more than 7 persons per campsite with a maximum of 4 adults
- Fires permitted in designated fire rings only
- Dogs on-leash in campground
- Pick up your dog's droppings
- From June 1 to September 15, dogs must be on leash when passing through beach and picnic areas and are not allowed to stay in these areas
- Alcohol not permitted outside individual campsite
- Smoking prohibited
- Camping permitted in designated sites only

### How to Get to There

Take BC-1 N (Trans Canada Highway). Take exit 14 from BC-1 N to Veterans Memorial Pkwy/BC-14 W in Langford. Turn right onto Sooke Rd/BC-14 W. Follow BC-14 (Juan de Fuca Highway) toward the town site of Jordan River, approximately 50 km. The Sandcut Beach parking area is about 4 km east of the Jordan River town site. The campground is 3.6 km west of Sandcut Beach.





