
Organics Origami


Use Black Press sized newspaper to make a liner for your kitchen organics container.

STEP 1 Lay two pieces of newspaper down as shown in the diagram below.


Next, lay two more pieces of newspaper on top to form a plus or cross.



STEP 2 Fold the stack of newspapers into a triangle. *Tip: Imagine that the stack is a complete square and the corners are filled.*




STEP 3 Fold corner A to middle of B and C, and fold corner of C to middle of A and B.




Organics Origami

Use Black Press sized newspaper to make a liner for your kitchen organics container.


STEP 4 Fold down half of the newspaper at point B on one side. Next, flip it over and fold the remaining layers down on the other side.



STEP 5 To further secure your bin liner, open the pocket and snip down one inch on each side. Next, fold over the edges once more to "lock" the folds on each side.



Once you are finished constructing your bin liner, open the pocket and slide into your kitchen catcher.
