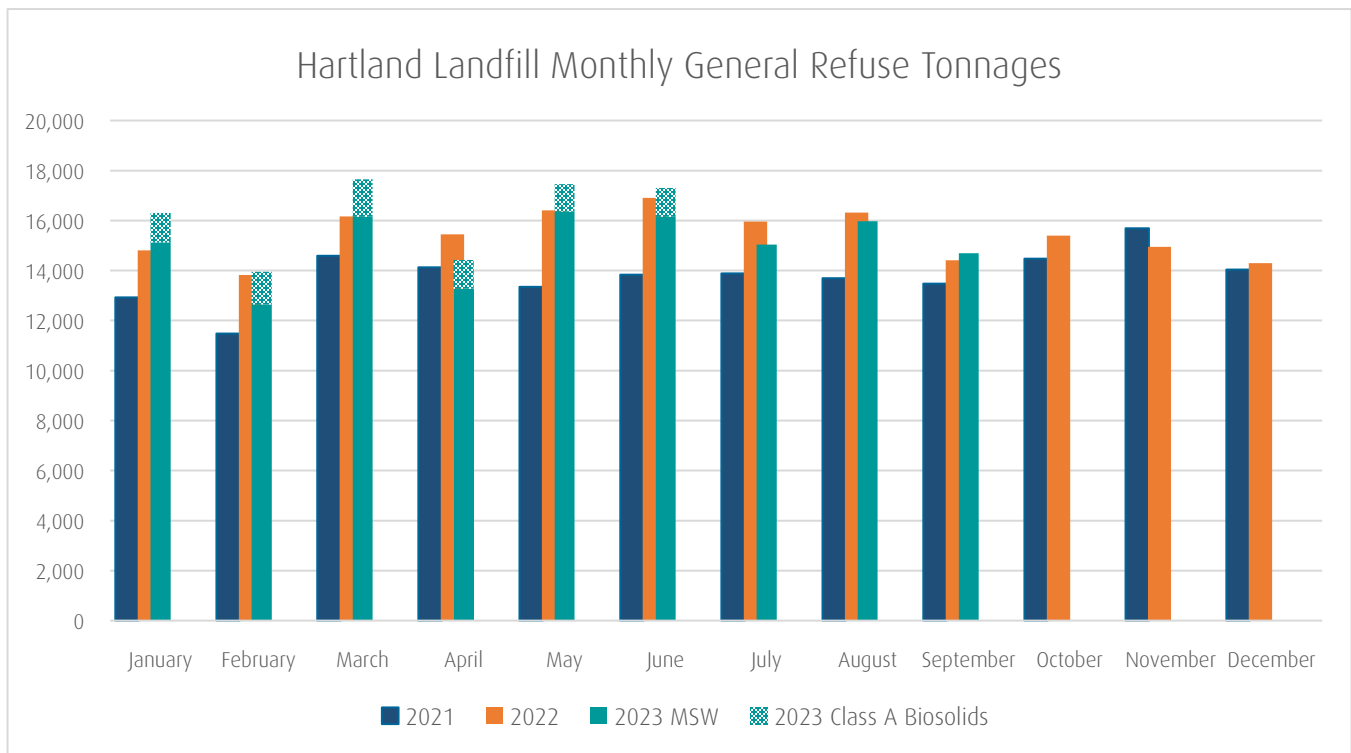

Summary of General Refuse Received at Hartland Landfill

In September 2023*, 14,691 tonnes of mixed solid waste was received at Hartland Landfill as general refuse. This represents an increase of 2% over the same month in 2022.

The capital region's annual waste generation rate for 2023 is estimated to be 402 kg/capita. The regional per capita estimate is based on a forecast and is expected fluctuate throughout the year.

Monthly refuse tonnage rates for Hartland and per capita disposal rates for the capital region from 2021 to 2023 are as follows:



* In September 2023, Hartland Landfill received 272 tonnes of Non-Class A Biosolids, produced at the Residuals Treatment Facility (RTF), as a controlled waste.
