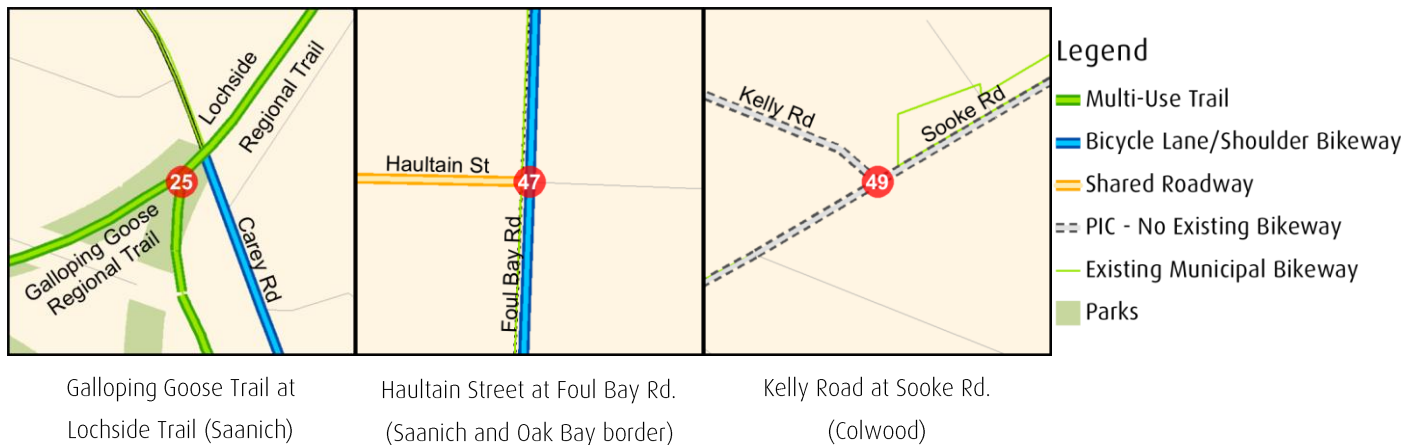


Cyclist Volume throughout the Day

In January 2013, an all-day count was undertaken at three locations on the three count days from January 8-10 to determine average volume and provide calibration data with existing datasets such as the Origin & Destination surveys. The three stations represent a broad cross section of types of facilities – from fully separated trails to bikeways and bike lanes to no bicycle-specific facilities.

Maps of Count Stations



The counts showed that volumes varied considerably from Tuesday to Thursday, reflecting the change in weather, from heavy rains on the first count day to clear and cold on the last. However, all counts reflected the expected morning and evening peaks, although the Regional trail had a sharper peak than the on-street location. Shaded areas show the AM peak of 7-9am and the PM peak of 3-6pm.
