High amounts of solids and other materials discharged to the sanitary sewer from denture clinics located throughout the capital region have the potential to block pipes and cause abrasion of pumps in sewage collection and treatment systems.

In order to reduce the amount of solids entering our sanitary sewer system, please ensure that the best management practices on this card are followed.

1. Install a solids interceptor, or similar equipment, under the sink to remove solids from dentalstone grinding and washing operations.
2. Keep detailed records for all disposal or recycling services used for solids and other substances, including wastes that are prohibited or restricted under Bylaw 2922.
3. Please ensure that all sanitary sewer discharges from your facility are in accordance with Bylaw 2922 and the procedures specified above. Please notify the CRD of any change in occupancy or use of this property.
