Commercial Aerator Replacement Program



Increased handwashing due to COVID-19 sanitation protocols can also mean an increase in water use and the associated costs for businesses and institutions, during an already challenging time.

Capital Regional District (CRD) staff will come to any business or institution that uses water supplied by the CRD and assess the faucets on all hand wash sinks. If the faucet is not operating at the maximum water efficiency, we will remove the aerator on your faucet and replace it with a new low flow aerator at no cost.

A new aerator uses less than two litres of water per minute (compared to 11 litres per minute on older faucets) and will dramatically reduce the amount of excess water used, while saving money and reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
