How to get involved

- Using Facebook, comment on the CRD's native species garden prize giveaway contest post with an answer to the question "What native plants grow in your yard?"
- All entries received between Wednesday, October 14 at 11:45AM PST and Sunday, October 18 at 11:59PM PST will be entered in a random draw for one of three prize packages.
- One eligible winner will be selected by draw on Monday, October 19 to receive a free 90-minute garden consultation with Saanich Native Plants (worth \$150).
- This contest is open to residents of the Capital Regional District. No purchase necessary. Odds of winning are dependent on the number of people who enter. Facebook use is required for this contest.

- **Read these terms and conditions carefully as they affect your legal rights.**
- The Capital Regional District ("CRD") native species garden prize giveaway contest (the "Contest") is governed by these terms and conditions. By entering, the entrant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions. If you do not agree, do not enter the contest.
- Failure to comply with these terms and conditions may result in disqualification or nullify the entrant from participation in the Contest.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND CONTEST DEADLINES

- The Contest will open on Wednesday, October 14 at 11:45AM PST and close on Sunday, October 18 at 11:59PM PST. Only one entry per entrant. Subsequent Facebook "comments" are not considered entries into the Contest and will be disqualified. Submissions received by any method other than Facebook comments will not be accepted.
- All post comments (contest entries) received during the contest period will be ascribed a number and entered to win using a random draw generator. On Monday, October 19 by 11:59PM PST, a random draw will be conducted to select one (1) winner for the one (1) 90-minute garden consultation. Saanich Native Plants Ltd. is an independent company and not an agent of the CRD.
- Winner will collect their prize in person at CRD Headquarters located at 625 Fisgard Street, Victoria, BC by Friday, October 30 at 4:30PM PST. Prizes which are not collected become the property of the CRD and may be redistributed to other entrants by random draw at the CRD's discretion. The prize shall be accepted as is and may not be substituted for an amount of money. No substitutions will be allowed. Any unused portion of a prize will become the property of the CRD. The prize is non-transferrable and non-assignable. Refusal to accept the prize releases the CRD from any obligation toward the selected winner.

- Selected winners will be notified by Facebook message within 48 hours of the draw of their eligibility for a prize. The selected winners will be required to acknowledge via e-mail receipt of the notification of eligibility. If no response is received within two (2) days of initial notification, the prize will be forfeited and an alternative winner from the remaining eligible entries will be selected. Up to two redraws will be made for each prize.
- To be declared a winner, a selected winner must, at the CRD's discretion a) confirm their identity and eligibility for the Contest, including proof of age and jurisdiction; b) sign a release releasing the CRD from all liability for any damage or loss arising from participation in this Contest or from the awarding, acceptance or use of the prize.
