For Rock Walls, Rocky Surfaces, Cracks and Crevices

- Stonecrop (*Sedum spathulifolium*, *lanceolatum*, *oregonum*) – evergreen with yellow flower
- Nodding onion (*Allium cernuum*) – evergreen with nodding pink/mauve flower
- Pussytoes (*Antennaria microphylla*, *A. neglecta*) – flowers are like pussy toes
- Alumroot (*Heuchera micrantha*) – evergreen, very hardy
- Licorice fern (*Polypodium glycyrrhiza*) – dies back in summer, winter green, likes shade
- Sword fern (*Polystichum munitum*) – evergreen, likes shade
- Camas (*Camassia quamas*, *C. leichtlinii*) – purple flower, bulb
- Satin flower (*Sisyrinchium douglasii*) – dainty purple early spring flower
- Blue-eyed mary (*Collinsia grandiflora*) – annual
- Sea blush (*Plectritis congesta*) – annual, pink flowers spread easily
- Spring gold (*Lomatium utriculatum*) – yellow flower
- Shooting star (*Dodecatheon hendersonii*) – magenta comet-like flower
- Hooker's onion (*Allium acuminatum*) – purple flowers bloom later in spring
- Woolly sunflower (*Eriophyllum lanatum*) – bright yellow daisy-like flower
- Sea thrift (*Armeria maritima*) – mounded plant with white/pink flowers
- Kinnikinick (*Artostaphylos uva-ursi*) – evergreen ground cover
- Penstemon (*Penstemon serrulatus*, *P. fruticosus*) – tubular purple/mauve flowers
- Menzie's larkspur (*Delphinium menziesii*) – blue flower
- Saxifrage (*Saxifraga integrifolia*) – clusters of small white flowers.
- Harebell (*Campanula rotundifolia*) – charming blue bell-shaped flower
- Fool's onion (*Brodiaea hyacinthina*) – white flower, long stem
- Harvest brodiaea (*Brodiaea coronaria*) – tiny purple flowers bloom in summer
- Monkey flower (*Mimulus alsinoides*, *M. guttatus*) – tiny yellow flowers, moist crevices
- Goldenback fern (*Pityrogramma triangularis*) – shaded moist crevices
- Parsley fern (*Cryptogramma crispa*)
