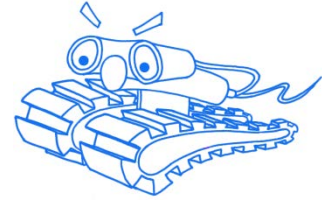

GANGES SEWER SERVICE

NOTICE TO BUSINESSES AND HOME OWNERS: SEWER CLEANING and CCTV INSPECTION

Dear Resident:

The Capital Regional District (CRD) has tendered a contract for the cleaning and closed circuit television (CCTV) inspection of sewer pipes in the Ganges Sewer service area. IPI Tech Inc. is the prime contractor and they will be using Pipe-Eye Services Ltd. to complete the work. The work is scheduled to start in the **last week of October** and it could take about **4-5 weeks to complete**. Generally, work hours will be between **7:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday to Friday**.

This work involves the cleaning of sewers using a high pressure jet and removing the debris from the pipe, followed by inserting a CCTV camera into the sewer to inspect and record the condition of the pipe and where unwanted rain and groundwater may be leaking into the sewer system.

Large trucks are required to complete the cleaning and inspection work. Traffic and parking along some roadways or driveways may be interrupted while performing the work. During the flushing and cleaning period loud noise can be expected, but every effort will be made to minimize duration of the noise.

During the cleaning work, some odour may be detected and air movement may cause some bubbling or splashing in your toilet. Therefore, it is recommended that you keep your toilet lid down at all times when not in use.
