

Water Main Upgrade Notice to Residents: Latoria Rd







Beginning Monday, Nov 6, 2017, CRD construction crews will begin the replacement of existing water main on Latoria Rd. This project will take approximately three (3) weeks to complete.

Construction noise and temporary traffic delays can be expected during regular working hours throughout this time. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist traffic through the construction zone.



What to Expect During Construction

- Construction noise and temporary traffic delays can be expected during regular working hours throughout this time
- Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist traffic through the construction zone
- Residents will be notified in advance of all scheduled water shut downs, but temporary shut downs may occur without warning.
- Excavations will be fenced or coned. Please do not move any construction materials during this time.

	<p><u>Work Hours:</u> Work will take place from 7am to 4:30pm, Monday to Friday.</p>
	<p><u>Road and Sidewalk Access:</u> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><u>Driveway Access:</u> The CRD will notify you of any temporary restrictions to driveway access.</p>
	<p><u>Traffic Management:</u> Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist traffic through the construction zone for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect moderate to significant delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p>
	<p><u>Parking:</u> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work, you may be asked to relocate it.</p>
	<p><u>Water Service Interruptions:</u> Residents will be notified in advance of all scheduled water shut downs, but temporary shut downs may occur without warning.</p>
	<p><u>Restoration:</u> The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced.</p>
